HEFFERMAN raced well placed early, bid four wide after five furlongs to challenge for and gain the lead then drew off steadily when roused. NANA'S HOPE made a middle move, fanned five wide then was up for the place late. JACK'S ROMA made a middle move but lodged only a mild bid in the stretch. PARADISE DANCER pressed early, gained a short lead in the second turn then gave way. BIG ROYAL ELTISH also duelled for the lead early then came up empty. ROBYN IT raced evenly. SHOT GUN CLIFF failed to menace. TECHNICAL EXPRESS vied inside early then faded. QUICK N PINK was no factor. BK'S CLEARANCEISLE stopped.
