ANISE'S WILD GIRL dueled inside to the stretch then slowly weakened. GRADUATION PARTY passed tiring rivals. ROLLY'S BABYSNOOKS was shuffled back at the break. OH SO WONDERFUL pressed inside to the turn then faltered. LYNI DE LOU was through early.
