ON THE VINEYARD chased the leader outside, bid after three furlongs, shook clear in the furlong grounds then prevailed under steady handling. HOW'S YOUR HALO raced close up from the outset, couldn't reach the winner in the drive but outfinished the rest. RUBY'S RED SOCKS was shuffled back early, bid outside after a half but weakened late. DUKES FLYING TIGER raced close up but failed to respond. CUSTER was void of speed to the stretch then was going well outside but too late. HYPOCRITE failed to threaten. RIGHT FLANKER popped the starting gate prior to the start then was through early. ROMAN CANDLES was no factor. REPENTING broke through the gate pre start then was also through early. STRADIVINSKY stopped.
