Footnotes

TAMBORIM raced close up from the outset, bid outside in the second turn to gain a short lead into the stretch, held on well when headed in the furlong grounds then came back on again to narrowly prevail. DUKE OF MISCHIEF made a middle move through the second turn, angled inside in the drive then closed fast along the rail but too late. CHEEKS MALONE was never far back, bid three wide leaving the second turn, held a short lead a furlong out but hung late then pulled up in distress. ADARI was fractious in the gate then was slowly gaining four wide late. SWEETLANDOFLIBERTY passed tiring rivals. DECAF AGAIN was well placed early then faded. BALLY BUFF was in tight and forced to take up early. GO TEBOW GO was fractious in the gate, set a solid pace then came up empty. IMMORTAL WINK vied for the lead early then faded. CAPULET was no factor. VINNIES WILD TALE showed little. BOSTON WEST END was fractious in the gate then showed little.
