WILLA CATHER set the pace off the rail, drifted out leaving the second turn then was no match for the winner while outfinishing the rest. SKIP TO SAVANNAH made a middle move to the stretch but failed to sustain that rally. GEBB'S PRINCESS chased the leader for six furlong but failed to respond out of the turn. ESPECIALLY WILD was well placed for six furlongs then faded. DAVES BABY failed to menace. ITALIAN SLEW chased to the quarter pole then gave way. STORM'S CUP showed little. THANK YOU DEAR was through early. The portable inner rail was set at 22 feet.
