ASTORBILT looped rivals four wide to challenge for and gain the lead into the stretch then was strongly handled to hold a safe margin through the drive. ISLE OF TUNES raced close up early, bid out of the turn but couldn't stay with the winner while saving the place. DANCE MATTIC sprinted clear from the outside, set a fast pace into the stretch then gradually weakened. PERFECT TEN raced close up to upper stretch then gave way. ROBYN SINGS was no factor. DEMUS was shuffled back early and was no factor. MARK AIM FIRE broke awkwardly, rushed up inside into the turn then came up empty. RUCKUSLADY showed little. CONCERTA stopped.
