GUARDIANOFTHEGATE stalked the pace for six furlongs, bid passing the quarter pole to open a good lead a furlong out then was roused to hold sway late. SIR BRIAN'S SWORD was boxed inside and behind rivals through the second turn then finished willingly once clear but couldn't get to the winner while outfinishing the rest for the place. LOVE THE GAME angled outside out of the second turn then was gaining ground well late. FINAL PROPHECY was blocked through the second turn then was in tight quarters along the inside while attempting to rally in the furlong grounds and finished well once clear. STOKOSKY was shuffled back on the backstretch, made a five wide middle move to be in striking position out of the second turn then weakened in the drive. ORCHARD PARK was run into a switch behind and inside rivals into the second turn then failed to gain once clear. MARQUETTE passed tiring rivals. GENERALS SWORD was no factor. LUCKY J J set the pace to the quarter pole then faded. MILITARY MAN was also well placed to the quarter pole then faded. EMERGENCY STATUS stopped. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
