J J SILVER BLUSH pressed the pace three wide from the outset, shook off WHATANACTRESS leaving the furlong grounds and slowly drew off late under pressure. BEAUTIFUL STARLET stalked the early leaders, bid four wide out of the turn then hung late while saving the place. STARRY MARK was void of early speed then closed a gap too late. DIAMOND MINE made a middle move to be in striking distance out of the turn but failed to sustain that rally. WHATANACTRESS vied for the lead to mid stretch then weakened. GRINDSTONE'S TINA was off slow, rushed to the lead inside then came up empty after five furlongs. SELVA MIA gradually weakened. OUR LEGEND was through early. JENA'S HOPE showed little.
