QUIZ WHIZ broke alertly, set a solid pace, drew off to mid stretch then just lasted late. AMERICAN RANSOM was never far back, settled into the stretch then closed fast but too late. IRISHWOODS was well placed but failed to gain. BERNARDUS chased early, bid after five furlongs then weakened. SLEWEY passed tiring rivals. STAR FLYER raced evenly. DUFFY'S PREDICTION was no factor. JAYHAWK INDEED was through after a half. QUICK TO RISE broke awkwardly, lost contact with the field after six furlongs and was outdistanced.
