**Footnotes**

FROSTY PEACE, unhurried to the second turn, advanced rapidly after five furlongs, bid four wide passing the furlong marker and was up in the final strides. IOYA TWO dueled for the lead inside from the outset, held on well when headed by IN THE SUN then came on again inside late. IN THE SUN, close up from the start, led briefly in the drive then hung late. DON'T BUCK CHOICE, well placed, lacked a late response. STE. ANNE passed tiring rivals. FOREVER CINDY was bumped at the start then showed little. LADY BLUE CHARGER never threatened. SPORTIE DELITE turned in a dull effort. TIGER PASS stopped as did STAR OF FIELD. (The portable inner rail was set out 22 feet.)
