DIPLOMAT'S REWARD raced close up from the outset, held on well when MANNY'S D ACTOR drew off leaving the second turn then wore that one down in the late stages under brisk handling. MANNY'S D ACTOR chased the early leader, moved to a clear lead into the second turn, drew off to mid stretch then faltered late while best of the rest. STACY'S BOY made a middle move to mid stretch but failed to sustain that rally late. THUNDERING STORM was well placed but had no rally. NASTY BRUSH made an outside middle move then came up empty. THE LONESOME ROAD passed tiring rivals. SARGENT OATES was through after a half. SURE UH HUH was through early. FIRE DEVIL raced evenly. WIGGY'S BEST stopped.
