**Footnotes**

THETACTICS OFDANCE made an inside middle move, angled out four wide into the stretch then after rallying past the leaders through the furlong grounds, lasted late under pressure. PATTIANO also made an inside middle move, was blocked and boxed behind rivals in mid stretch then altered course outside the winner and was gaining late. CHANGING WORLD also advanced inside after five furlongs, got through along the rail to challenge in mid stretch and gain a clear lead but hung late. CHANCEY LIGHT was void of speed for six furlongs then lodged a mild rally late. PHONE THE DIVA hopped at the break, advanced inside into the second turn then took up sharply over rivals' heels at the quarter pole and failed to fully recover. SING TO THE SKY chased the early leader, bid after five furlongs then weakened under pressure. SECRET LIES raced evenly. DEBERE failed to menace. SKIP'S SINGER showed little. DESTINY SAY'S stopped. YES IT'S GOLD rushed to a long lead but had little left after six furlongs. SUCHATOUCH stopped. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
