RISINGALMA made an inside middle move to get through leaving the turn then was fully extended to emerge from a long drive with a clear lead late. PANTHERILLA also made a middle move, split rivals in upper stretch to loom a threat then hung late while outfinishing the rest. BOOK A DOUBLE dueled to the late stages and weakened. EXCLUSIVE XODA bore out early, pressed the pace to mid stretch then weakened. COASTAL DIXIE lodged a mild late rally. PRECIOUS SECRET broke poorly. WAR MAIDEN showed little. FRIENDLY COYOTE was no factor. MS CHIEF HONCHO was through early. LITTLE SKEETER stopped and was outdistanced.
