BEST WESTERNER pressed the pace from the outset, couldn't stay with the winner in the drive but saved the place. WILLSBORO POINT made a middle move through the second turn then was slowly gaining. CHALLENGE PRIDE looped wide through the second turn then weakened. YOU THE MAN passed tiring rivals. CHIRAC was through after a half. OHIO'S WAY failed to threaten. TRUE BLUE FINGERS was no factor. FLASHY WONDER was fractious in the gate then stopped.
