ALISA'S ENGINEER stalked the leaders, bid three wide entering the far turn and drew clear under urging. LONGHAMMER raced off the pace, came three wide into the lane and made a late run outside for second. RIO GREY raced off the rail, advanced outside on the far turn and needed more. EVERYOTHERDAYHERO raced off the pace and failed to threaten. SAND BANDIT raced off the pace inside, advanced outside a rival on the turn and was outfinished. MEMORYS N DREAMS tracked the pace, bid between rivals and faded. FABLEDZAPPER raced off the pace inside, chased on the far turn and faded. FOCUS POINT raced off the rail and did not factor. ARCTICAN BREEZE set the pace, gave way and stopped. LONG TO WIN stumbled badly in the early stages, was pulled up entering the backside and vanned off. After a Stewards' Inquiry, the race was declared official.
