BAHIM raced close up early, bid three wide in the turn, drew off to mid stretch then was roused to prevail late. BRING DA RUCKUS raced close up from the start, was slowly gaining on the winner late and was best of the rest. MING DYNASTY was also well placed but could offer only a mild rally. ROMAN BAY made up minor ground late. GRANBY BOY vied for a half then gave way. AMY'S BUDDHA dueled into the stretch then weakened. SONNY AND LOUIE raced evenly. MANNY WHO was no factor. OAK FOREST showed little. HE'S APPEALING was used up early. LAKEVILLE RUSH trailed.
