DR. CASOLA stalked the leaders early, bid out of the turn then dueled past mid stretch before shaking free while drifting in. J. GORDON raced close up from the outset, bid in the turn, gained the lead between calls then resisted the winner past mid stretch before steadying and altering course outside that one late. BOMBER BEAU was forwardly placed but lacked a strong late response. EXIT CARD passed tiring rivals. BRONSONSTORM raced evenly. AMERICAN CAT failed to menace. GOLDCARDMEMBER was no factor. INUKSUK pressed the issue for more than a half then faded. LOVE HUNT turned in a dull effort. DEVONFORD stopped. HUNTING IN GERARDA showed little.
