STREET HAVEN looped four wide moving to contention out of the second turn, was no match for the winner but bested the rest. BIG GAVEL made a middle move then lodged a mild rally. GET READY GO broke awkward then passed faders. MR. SLUGGO pressed the pace, gained a short lead in the second turn then weakened in the drive. GEODI'S GOLD chased early, bid in the second turn then flattened out. HEY JOHNNY JOHNNY was through after a half. RED RANGER was fractious in the gate. FOUR F'S AND A D showed little. BARBEHONOR stopped.
