STAYO was never far back, bid after six furlongs and was up for the place late. BARBADA made a middle move then was slowly gaining outside. MEMORYS N DREAMS raced evenly. JAMESTOWN set a slow pace early then weakened after six furlongs. SABANERO was no factor. ALASKAN CAUSEWAY was hung wide early then gave way. JIM N JOHN trailed.
