Footnotes

BOASTFUL was unhurried early while four wide, advanced out of the second turn then ran down the leader in the late stages. BALANCE THE BOOKS sprinted clear early, held a long lead into the stretch but couldn't last while saving the plasce. INFINITE JUSTICE chased the leader much of the way, rallied inside leaving the final turn but was outkicked late. AWOL SOLDIER angled outside in the furlong grounds but lacked a strong late response. CREEK'S SHORE raced evenly. TOTAL ANILATION stumbled badly at the break. AMON failed to threaten. DYNAMIC VISION was no factor. RAYMOND SPRINGS failed to menace. BLAINE'S STORM showed little. The portable inner rail was set out 22 feet.
