RAHOO made a middle move, angled out five wide then drove past the leaders along the outside late. LITE BRIGADE stalked the pace inside, angled out four wide to challenge out of the turn then after drawing even late, hung. NOBLE TIGER was void of speed to the stretch then closed fast but too late. CONRAD CROSSING fanned widest of all then was gaining outside latew. BULLET FROM ABROAD dueled past mid stretch before weakening. XEP FOR ELMER raced evenly. COUNT ON IT vied for the lead to upper stretch then gave way. SUPER STRUGGLER stopped. TIME FOR TRUTH stopped.
