WHY WHY WHY AMOUR set a solid pace, shook off a bid from AWESOME VOW after five furlongs, drew off to the furlong marker and prove clearly best under brisk handling. GRAND BAHAMA was well placed much of the trip, was no match for the winner but was up for the place late. OFFER was slow to settle then closed late outside. AWESOME VOW chased early, bid after five furlongs then weakened in the drive. GISELLE MA BELLE was well placed but had no rally. SHALL WE GATHER showed some interest but too late. EAGER LEADER raced evenly. SEBRING AT SUNSET was through early. ROYALLY SWEET pressed the issue early then came up empty. MAJOR MASABI showed little'.
