Footnotes

GOLD BREW was void of early speed, advanced through the second turn, fanned five wide for the drive then was up in the final strides after a long drive.

STUMBLING BLOCK stalked the pace early, bid four wide into the stretch, drew even for the lead into the final furlong then was just outkicked late.

SWITCHING TO GLIDE chased early, bid leaving the second turn then dueled into the final furlong before weakening. SLEW CITY STORM set a moderate

pace to the final furlong then gave way.
