CLIPPER WON was unhurried early, made a four wide middle move to challenge for the lead out of the second turn then was up late under brisk handling. THE LONESOME ROAD was well placed, made a four wide middle move to challenge for and gain the lead after five furlongs then showed strong stamina to resisted the winner well to late before hanging while second best. NASTY BRUSH made a middle move and lodged a mild rally. SATIN CREEK pressed the pace early then gradually weakened. STACY'S BOY dueled inside for six furlongs then faded. THUNDERING STORM was well placed to the stretch then came up empty. TIM'S BEST raced evenly. FIRE DEVIL showed little. SARGENT OATES stopped.
