STORM'S APPEAL was unhurried early, advanced in traffic through the second turn, angled outside into the stretch then wore down FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE in the late stages. FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE chased the leader early, took a clear lead in the second turn then continued well through the drive and just failed to last. HELLCAT PILOT made a middle move to the stretch then gave way. WILLIWAGCANFLY was well placed but had no rally. PERSONAL COPY set a solid early pace then weakened. JOHN MORGAN failed to menace. SOUSED was through early. JERICHO PLAZA stopped. ALL CHANCE checked at the break then was no factor.
