Footnotes

ITS HIS TIME was boxed and forced to wait to the quarter pole, angled outside to bid after five furlongs then drifted in a bit while shaking off PAWNSAY leaving the furlong grounds. PAWNSAY raced close up early, bid in the turn to gain a short lead into the stretch then steadied slightly inside the winner while that one was moving clear inside the final furlong. SECRET FEVER dueled to the stretch then weakened. CAPTAIN CAMERON was well placed but had no rally. FLYINGPALM was through after a half. ARMORED TRUCK stopped. There was a stewards inquiry and claim of foul by the rider of PAWNSAY against the winner but the results were permitted to stand as posted. ROTATION showed little .
