FULL HORSE POWER stalked the pace early, bid after a half to gain a short lead in the drive then hung late. SKIMATIC made a middle move to challenge into the stretch then weakened in the final furlong. MY TOUGH TIGER made a mild rally late. BULLSEYE BOY passed tiring rivals. SAINT FROM SPAIN was used up. JOVIAL MAN was through after a half. HARD TWO IMAGINE was no factor. SMOOTH GLITTER stopped.
