SUMMER INTERLUDE tracked the pace on the inside, gained a short lead through the second turn, then dueled through the lane with LADY OF THE GLEN and held sway over that one. LADY OF THE GLEN mid pack, gained a striking position three wide through the second turn, bid outside the leader into the stretch, dueled with that one and hung. NICE CALL never far back, gained position two and three wide through the second turn, angled in and came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then closed well for the show. POLO IS CHEAPER rated back early, looped up three wide through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch and closed fast to gain a share, while missing the show. BITTER TEARS gained a striking position inside while boxed, steadied for racing room through the second turn, angled out to bid three wide and flattened out. DOUBLE DINNERMINT never far back, steadily moved up, then had no stretch rally. CALANDRA improved her position. VAGUELYDISTINCTIVE sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, then faded in the drive. TEUFFELIZED was no factor. PASSIONFORWINNING well placed, faded after a half.
