SUMMERHILL GAL stalked the early pace, bid three wide through the second turn then drew off through the final furlong. VELVET DRIVE made a four wide middle move then outfinished the rest while unable to stay with the winner. SHINGALANA made a five wide move to contention through the second turn but failed to sustain that bid. DASH ON HOLME dueled early, gained a clear lead briefly passing the quarter pole but weakened in the final furlong. STRIKETHGOLD LASS chased the leaders for six furlongs but faded late. CHIQUI PINE was unhurried to the stretch. CHOCOLATE KISSES was used up. SPIRIT OF FLAG was hard used then gave way. THE BANKERS MINE showed little. LATECIA'S LAST was no factor. The portable inner rail was set at 12 feet.
