COPELAN'S SILVER was away alertly to gain the early lead, was unchallenged setting a moderate pace then drew off after six furlongs and was clearly best under intermittent pressure. LOST made a middle move to contention and was easily best of the rest. MR TWIST stalked the pace but failed to respond when called upon. NEW EPISODE passed tiring rivals late. THUNDERING STORM was well placed to the quarter pole then faded. EXCLUSIVELY RISQUE gradually weakened. AGRONOMIST was no factor. PRINCE SKIF chased three wide then came up empty. TWO SPOTS was pulled up on the backstretch.
