MONT VENTOUX came in early, set a slow pace, held on well when headed then came back on again to narrowly prevail after a long drive. TIME FOR TUTT steadied early, went after the leader after three furlongs, gained a short lead in the second turn then continued gamely to late before being outkicked. HURRICANE DAY was unburied early then made up minor ground late. H M S ANNIVERSARY pressed early then gave way. CHABICHOU raced evenly. FRATELLO failed to menace. RALEIGH EXPRESS showed little. STRETCH OUT stopped. INVISIBLE GENIUS showed little. A claim of foul by the rider of TIME FOR TUTT against the winner for interference after the break was disallowed.
