TRUTHFUL SAINT was slow to settle then closed a gap but too late. RUN JAC RUN passed tiring rivals. YARDSALE ON WHEELS was well placed for six furlongs then gave way. ZEN IMPERIALISM raced evenly. EL CHICOTICO was through after a half. DANCES ON THE SEAS set a moderate pace into the stretch then faltered late. LOVERS REVENGE stopped.
