SNAKES HEATHER was unprepared at the start, advanced steadily after a half and was up for the place inside while no match for the winner. DEVIL SMILES rushed to the lead while refusing to rate kindly early, was no match for the winner when challenged then weakened in the drive. MAMATASS made a middle move but failed to sustain that rally. TURKOGIRL passed tiring rivals. SHEGOTITALL made a middle move then came up empty. RISINGALMA chased the leader for five furlongs and faded. NEED THE QUEEN was no factor. PRIZED ACK trailed. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
