Footnotes

LAMBANA stalked the early pace, bid after five furlongs then shook off CORPORATE COURIER leaving the furlong marker to draw away late. The latter dueled for the early lead with GLEN SAVOYE while saving ground, resisted the winner well to late and was clearly second best. NO COMPLAINTS made up ground to the stretch then went evenly. NOBLE PRIEST passed tiring rivals. SKYSTICK broke poorly. GAMBLE MANSION failed to threaten. TRINIDAD EXPRESS went evenly. BRAZEN HEAD was through after a half. ROMANTIC DANCER flashed brief speed. GLEN SAVOYE rushed up to contest the pace to the second turn, stopped and was not pressured in the lane when badly beaten. (The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.)
