PURELY PERFECT set a fast pace, drew off leaving the turn to mid stretch but couldn't last. BRIDESMAID IN SILK was well placed but failed to gain. WICKED MOON lodged a mild rally inside late. REPENT'S GEM was hung wide in an even effort. WIN JANE'S HEART passed tiring rivals. SWEET INSPIRATION was no factor. DESIRABLE DESIREE showed little. BEDOUIN chased into the stretch then faded. MISS MACHA was through early.
