PICA PICA made a four wide middle move to contention, fanned five wide out of the turn then challenged outside through the drive to gain a short lead late before turning back MISS PRIM near the wire. MISS PRIM fanned six wide out of the turn then was slowly gaining outside late. HAZELS BREW pressed the pace early, eased back to stalk outside, bid after a half to gain a short lead in the drive then hung late. FAVORITE RETURN was bumped at the break, made an inside middle move, got through along the rail to challenge a furlong out then weakened. SHE'S RISKY raced close up to the stretch then weakened. BUSINESS FIRST passed tiring rivals. NOUVELLE ORLEANS vied for the lead to the quarter pole then faded. OUR NIECE was no factor. DUCHESS ON THE RUN showed little. SHE'SJUSTBUSINESS was no factor. AMERICAN FOREST stopped. SHUTTHEFRONTDOOR was through early.
