IRISH LION made a three wide middle move to challenge into the stretch then drove past the leader leaving the furlong grounds to be along in time. AMBASSADOR OF WAR dueled for six furlongs, shook clear into the stretch then just hung late. J ISLE raced boxed for five furlongs, angled outside in the drive then made a late gain. VALUEABLE SILVER dueled to the stretch then weakened. BAKYT failed to menace. EL UNO was well placed but had no rally. PLAY IT STRAIGHT showed little. PUT TO THE TEST was taken up at the break.
