LAURENS JESTER void of early speed, raced three wide around the final turn, rallied to take over in the drive and drew off under urging. ZEN IMPERIALISM stalked the pace between horses leaving the final turn and proved second best. SEEKING HARMONY in good position racing off the rail finished evenly. BURNING POINT bumped with SABANERO at the start, moved up to set the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. SABANERO bumped at the start with BURNING POINT and saved ground to no avail.
