ICE FOR THE LADY void of speed, moved up gradually into the turn, gained position three and four wide through the turn, then drew off in the lane and was kept to the task. BELLADINI sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, could not match strides with the winner in the lane, stayed on to hold the place safe and be clearly best of the rest. VIVA VIOLA well placed and outside, angled in and came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then weakened in the drive. BROADWAY PEYTON tracked the pace on the inside, dropped back slightly through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and held a share. FOLLOW MY LUCK showed little, widest. PAULO'S DELIGHT was no factor. PUSH mid pack and outside, moved up three wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch and faded in the drive. LUCI FERN broke a step slowly and was never involved.
