MY IRISH GIRL saved ground, got through along the rail in the furlong grounds to be a threat but was outkicked late. PAY THE MAN chased into the stretch then weakened. NATALICAT raced evenly. SARATOGA TANGO showed little. MIN D'ORO was no factor. CRIMSON BUCKY stopped.
