ANISE'S WILD GIRL vied for the early lead while well removed from the inner rail, drew off while still in the middle of the track after a half and was ridden out to prove best. PRESUME NOT made a middle move through the turn then split rivals in the stretch to outfinish the rest while no match for the winner. PISTOLS FLOWER chased the winner much of the way before weakening late. TIGER LIKE was well placed but had no rally. THE LADY WAFFLES passed tiring rivals late. TOUR ME HONEY raced evenly. MADAME LIL weakened gradually. ATYLIA was no factor. MACON DALE was through after a half. SWEET ELENA faded after a half. REASON TO BELIEVE showed little. MS. CIMARRON stopped.
