FILE GUMBO mid pack and inside, gained a striking position through the turn, angled out to bid three wide, then made a steady gain in the lane and drove clear. LIL ESCAPE ARTIST well placed and outside, moved up to challenge for and gain a short lead into the stretch, then could not match strides with the winner the final furlong, stayed on and held the place safe. FIFTH OF APRIL allowed to settle, looped up three wide through the turn, came four wide to bid and closed for the show. REIGNING LIVIA sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, stayed on when challenged into the stretch, then faded the final furlong. SOLARI ISLAND chased the pace off the rail and had no stretch rally. E STREET BOURBON showed little, widest. MOMS GLIDE was never involved.
