Footnotes

RIGHT FLANKER chased inside, got through along the rail to challenge into the stretch then had his rider strike BLIND RIVER FOX on the bridge of the nose with the whip in mid stretch then pulled away late. BLIND RIVER FOX dueled from the outset, was dueling for the lead when struck on the nose by the whip of RIGHT FLANK'S rider in mid stretch then weakened. BOOGIE WOOGIE MAN made a middle move to the stretch then split rivals to be in striking distance a furlong out but failed to sustain that rally. BELICHICK also made a middle move and also failed to sustain that rally in the final furlong. KIPPER'S NIGHT vied for the lead for a half then gave way. SAY IT ISN'T SOLD was no factor. POR FAVOR pressed the pace well wide then faded after a half. DRY ICE was through after a half. DEPUTY ON CALL was no factor. Following a claim of foul by the rider of BLIND RIVER FOX, RIGHT FLANK was disqualified from first and placed second for striking a rival with the whip in the drive.
