CURRAGH MON raced close up early, bid into the stretch, drifted out when COAST TO COAST came out a bit, carrying POWERHOUSE out a bit then held that one safe through a long drive. POWERHOUSE stalked the pace early, bid outside into the stretch, was carried a bit wide in upper stretch then continued well through the drive before hanging late. COAST TO COAST set a solid pace, drifted out slightly into the stretch then weakened late. GREAT CAUSE was hustled along but had no rally. FAVORITE PRANK raced evenly. SONNY B CRUISIN' showed little. FANCYFREEEVERETT was through early. WHA YOUDOIN trailed. There was a stewards inquiry and claim of foul by the rider of POWERHOUSE against the winner for interference in upper stretch but there was no action taken.
