CONSTABULARY broke slowly, was far back early, settled in the second turn then angled out four wide to challenge in the furlong grounds and was up late despite swerving out nearing the finish. MARCH TWELTH chased early, bid in the second turn, dueled through a long drive then just hung late. ALARMING AFLEET raced well placed early, bid in the second turn then dueled to the final furlong before weakening. ARTS AND LEISURE raced well placed but had no rally. HIGH BRASS was no factor. SWORD PLAY set a solid pace for almost six furlongs then faded. SUPERLOOK was through early then was outdistanced. SWEET FLEET FEET stopped and was also outdistanced.
