QUITE A DUDE raced close up three wide, bid in the second turn then dueled through a long drive before getting up late while brushing with STARSHIP SUPREME. STARSHIP SUPREME broke sharp, set a strong pace then resisted through the drive before just hanging while being brushed late by the winner. GALAXY TAX was void of speed to the quarter pole, angled to the middle of the course for the drive then closed fast but too late. SAM OWEN made a middle move then lodged a mild rally. BEANTOWN passed tiring rivals. CONRAD CROSSING was well placed then gave way. ISITTRUEMOSSY saved ground then came up empty. COLD ORIENT was no factor. TAXES TAXES TAXES chased early then faded. PLANT CITY RED stopped.
