COURTING CAT stalked the pace early, bid four wide into the stretch then was up in the final strides after a long drive. RON'S PERENNIAL dueled inside from the outset, resisted gamely when challenged in the drive and continued well to just miss. HUNGARIAN GENT made a middle move, was in striking distance into the final furlong but was outkicked late. SUNSET ESCAPADE got through inside in the drive and was gaining ground late. TAXICAB was well placed into the final furlong but lacked a strong late response. MARTICUS THE GREAT raced evenly. GOLDEN SEMINOLE vied for the lead to upper stretch then weakened. MERRY ANTHEM was through early. RED CAPTAIN was no factor. A SONG FOR SARAH stopped.
