YACHT CLUB was blocked inside and behind rivals early, angled outside into the second turn to loop rivals five wide moving to contention then ran past the leaders leaving the furlong marker to win going away. OLYMPIC ADVICE was void of early speed, made a quick move to contention through the second turn, led briefly in the stretch but was no match for the winner while besting the rest. FORTUNATE SWING split horses out of the second turn while in tight quarters, dueled past the furlong marker then weakened. RIGHT BACK ATCHA passed tiring rivals. FLYING LEA chased the early leaders, moved to a clear lead on the second turn then gave way in the final furlong. BETTY SPAGHETTI failed to menace. IMPROVISED chased for five furlongs then faded. SEAVENTURE was through after a half. MAKEMEMONEYHONEY stopped. NICOLE'S DREAM was used up early and stopped. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
