DILIGENT WON set a moderate pace under patient handling, shook off bids from both sides in the furlong grounds then pulled away late. TAME THE MANE chased from the outset, bid outside the winner into the stretch then weakened late while saving the place. DA MULLETT stalked the pace in traffic, got through inside to challenge along the rail through the furlong grounds then hung late. FUJIMO chased early, bid four wide in the second turn then gave way. ACERO BRAVE HEART raced evenly. OUTSHINE failed to threaten. WOODY'S APACHE was no factor. SPIKEAVELLIAN chased for six furlongs then came up empty. JACKIE'S PUNT broke in the air. DOC TOUR broke poorly.
