Footnotes

TURWADA stalked the early pace from between rivals, looped three wide through the turn, then bid four wide into the stretch, made a steady gain and drove clear late. COMITATUS gained a clear lead soon after the start, increased his lead, then was outfinished while clearly best of the rest. DEACON PAPA PETE well back and off the rail, gained position through the turn, bid four wide into the stretch, drifted in and had a mild gain. P. BUCK well placed and five wide, angled in slightly into the turn to move up, then ran evenly in the lane. SAINT FROM SPAIN improved position. BELIEVE IN WEST showed little. CRIMINAL OFFENSE stalked the early pace outside, looped rivals four wide through the turn, then had no rally. TIME TIX AHEAD was a brief factor, inside.
